





## 1. Exodus 19:1-4

‘On the third new moon after the Israelites had gone out of the land of Egypt, on that very day, they came into the wilderness of Sinai. They had journeyed from Rephidim [Exodus 17:1, 8], entered the wilderness of Sinai, and camped in the wilderness; Israel camped there in front of the mountain. Then Moses went up to God; YHWH called to him from the mountain, saying, ‘Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the Israelites: You have seen what I did to the Egyptians, and how I bore you on eagles’ wings and brought you to myself.



## Deuteronomy 32:11

‘As an eagle stirs up its nest, and hovers over its young;  
as it spreads its wings, takes them up, and bears them  
aloft on its pinions, YHWH alone guided him.’



## 2. Exodus 19:5

- Now therefore, if you obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession out of all the peoples.



## 2 Corinthians 3:6

‘He has made us to be ministers of a new covenant.’

## 1 Corinthians 11:25

‘This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.’

## John 13:34

‘I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you also should love one another.’



## Deuteronomy 32:11

If you obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession out of all the peoples.

## Deuteronomy 7:6

‘You are a people holy to YHWH your God; YHWH your God has chosen you out of all the peoples on earth to be his people, his treasured possession.’

## Deuteronomy 26:18

‘Today YHWH has obtained your agreement: to be his treasured people, as he promised you, and to keep his commandments.’



Malachi 3:17

‘They shall be mine, says YHWH of hosts,  
my special possession.’

Psalms 135:4

‘YHWH has chosen Jacob for himself, Israel as his  
own possession.’



## Exodus 19:6

Indeed, the whole earth is mine, but you shall be for me a priestly kingdom and a holy nation.

## Isaiah 61:6

‘You shall be called **priests** of YHWH, you shall be named ministers of our God.’



## 1 Peter 2:5, 9

‘Like living stones, let yourselves be built into a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s own people, in order that you may proclaim the mighty acts of him who called you out of darkness into his marvellous light.’

## Revelation 1:6

‘Jesus Christ made us to be a kingdom, priests serving his God and Father.’



### 3. Exodus 19:7-8

So Moses came, summoned the elders of the people, and set before them all these words that YHWH had commanded him. The people all answered as one: “Everything that YHWH has spoken we will do.” Moses reported the words of the people to YHWH.



#### 4. Exodus 19:9-12

‘YHWH said to Moses, “I am going to come to you in a dense cloud, in order that the people may hear when I speak with you and so trust you ever after ...  
“Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow. Have them wash their clothes and prepare for the third day, because on the third day YHWH will come down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people. You shall set limits for the people all around, saying: Be careful not to go up the mountain or to touch the edge of it. Any who touch the mountain shall be put to death. ...



## 5. Exodus 19:13-16

So Moses went down from the mountain to the people. He consecrated the people, and they washed their clothes. He said to the people, “Prepare for the third day ...”

On the morning of the third day there was thunder and lightning, as well as a thick cloud on the mountain, and a blast of a ram’s horn [shofar] so loud that all the people in the camp trembled.’



Hosea 6:2

‘On the third day he will raise us up, that we may live before him.’

Matthew 17:23

‘They will kill the Son of Man, and on the third day he will be raised.’

John 2:1

‘On the third day there was a wedding in Cana.’



## 6. Exodus 19:17-20

‘Moses brought the people out of the camp to meet God. They took their stand at the foot of the mountain. Now Mount Sinai was wrapped in smoke, because YHWH had descended upon it in fire; the smoke went up like the smoke of a kiln, while the whole mountain shook violently. As the blast of the horn grew louder and louder, Moses would speak and God would answer him in thunder. When YHWH descended upon Mount Sinai, to the top of the mountain, YHWH summoned Moses to the top of the mountain, and Moses went up.’



Matthew 5:1-2

‘Jesus went up the mountain. His disciples came to him and he taught them.’

Matthew 14:23

‘After Jesus had dismissed the crowds, he went up the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone.’

Matthew 15:29-30

Jesus went up the mountain, where he sat down. Great crowds came to him, bringing with them the lame, the maimed, the blind, the mute, and many others. They put them at his feet, and he cured them.



## Matthew 17:1-8

Jesus took with him Peter and James and John and led them up a high mountain, by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became dazzling white. Suddenly there appeared to them Moses and Elijah ... suddenly a bright cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud a voice said, “This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!” When the disciples heard this, they fell to the ground and were overcome by fear. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, “Get up and do not be afraid.” And when they looked up, they saw **no one except Jesus himself alone.**



## Matthew 28:16-20

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted.

And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”



## Hebrews 12:18-24

‘You have not come to something that can be touched, a blazing fire, and darkness, and gloom, and a tempest, and the sound of a trumpet, and a voice whose words made the hearers beg that not another word be spoken to them ... You have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering, and to the assembly of the firstborn who are enrolled in heaven, and to God the judge of all, and to the spirits of the righteous made perfect, and to Jesus, the mediator of a new covenant, and to the sprinkled blood that speaks a better word than the blood of Abel.’
